## Scholarship Fund Application

Sheena Villa was a beloved teacher of ballet, jazz and lyrical for six years at Miss Tanya's Expression of Dance. She also had a gift for making each student feel special. This scholarship fund was established in her name to encourage the EOD students to carry on Miss Sheena's tradition of embracing the joy and passion for dance. Each year scholarships are awarded to any current student in 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade. Students may only receive the scholarship one time. If a student applies for the scholarship but does not receive it, they may reapply the following year.

### Selection Policy

1. Application
2. Student Essay (hard copy or verbal video presentation)
3. 45-90 Second Dance/Acro Piece (video submission)
4. Availability of scholarship funds
5. Evaluation from teachers at Expression of Dance (will automatically be completed by teachers upon receipt of application)

Please use specific life experiences where appropriate.
2. DANCE/ACRO PIECE- In addition to your essay, you must submit a 45-90 second video of a dance or acro piece that you choreograph and perform. Please share this video through your google link. Please make sure your video is filmed from the front to showcase your performance fully.
